Wedding Photography Contract

- It is understood Chey Photography is the exclusive official photographer retained to perform the photographic services requested on this Contract.
- Chey Photography may substitute another photographer to take the photographs in the event of Photographer's illness. In the event of such substitution, Chey Photography warrants that the photographer taking the photographs shall be a competent professional.
- No part of any order, including previews, will be delivered until the balance is paid in full.
- Chey Photography reserves the right to use negatives and/or reproductions for advertising, display, publication or other purposes. Negatives and previews remain the exclusive property of Chey Photography.
- Upon signature, Chey Photography shall reserve the time and date agreed upon, and will not make other reservations for that time and date. For this reason the retainer is non-refundable, even if the date of the wedding is changed or the wedding is cancelled for any reason.
- A retainer of \$800 and a signed contract is necessary to reserve the date of the wedding.
- If Chey Photography cannot perform this Contract due to fire or other casualty, strike, act of God, or other cause beyond the control of the parties, or due to Photographer's illness or emergency, then the Photographer shall return the deposit to the Client but shall have no further liability with respect to the Contract. This limitation on liability shall also apply in the event that photographic materials are damaged in processing, lost through camera malfunction, lost in the mail, or otherwise lost or damaged without fault on the part of the Photographer. In the event Chey Photography fails to perform for any other reason, the Photographer shall not be liable for any amount in excess of the retail value of the Client's order.
- Completion of the desired photographs depends on all wedding participants' prompt readiness at the prearranged time. Any tardiness from this time may result in omission of photographs, although the Photographer will make every effort to complete the desired photographs within the scheduled time frame.
- Client is aware that color dyes in photography may fade or discolor over time due to the inherent qualities of dyes, and Client releases Photographer from any liability for any claims whatsoever based upon fading or discoloration due to such inherent qualities.
- The charges in this Contract are based on Chey Photography's Standard Price List. This price list is adjusted periodically and future orders shall be charged at the prices in effect at the time when the order is placed, unless within four months of wedding date.
- NOTICE OF COPYRIGHT: It is ILLEGAL to copy or reproduce these photographs elsewhere without the Photographer's permission, and violators of this Federal Law will be subject to its civil and criminal penalties.
- Engagement sessions must be photographed at least eight weeks prior to wedding date in order to process portrait and book orders for the wedding day. These may be processed in less time, but photographer cannot make any guarantees.
- Wedding albums are customized to each clients' order, & therefore may take up to six months to be completed from the date we receive all image suggestions from the client. If client is unresponsive photographer reserves the right to order products for the client or charge a fee for cost of goods rising. Products will be ordered based on photographer's own judgment or last communication from client.
- Payment schedule is as follows: \$800 non-refundable retainer. Remainder of balance due 45 days before wedding day. (Payment plans are available).
- This Contract incorporates the entire understanding of the parties. Any modifications of this Contract must be in writing and signed by both parties.
